

He was making a good postoperative recovery and had his urinary catheter removed 48h ago. He reports no chest symptoms. He is eating and drinking and has opened his bowels normally. He passed urine 2h ago. His past medical his- tory includes hypertension and . Up until 3 years ago he smoked 20 cigarettes a day. He does not drink alcohol. He is married and is a retired accountant. Examination, He has a temperature of 37.8°C with a pulse rate of 92/min and a blood pressure of 114/82mmHg. The oxygen saturations are 96 per cent on room air. He is comfortable in bed but looks flushed. He is orientated in time, place and person. His cardiorespiratory and abdominal examinations are unremarkable. The wound looks dry and the knee has a typical postoperative appearance.



Sometimes he suffers shocking at when sleeping. Despite this, he denies any weight loss and feels well in himself. He has been a heavy smoker for about 40 years. He has not been to his GP before, as he thought the heartburn was probably related to his smoking. He is now concerned about his difficulty in swallowing.

By examination There are no abnormal physical signs on full examination. An oesophagogastroduodenoscopy (OGD) is performed and a picture is taken.
