SELECTION OF SOME PROMISING LINES THROUGH PEDIGREE METHOD IN OKRA.

ABSTRACT

The present investigation was carried out with the purpose of selecting new economic okra strains through pedigree method. In this respect, four original cultivars were previously crossed. The resulting F1's of them were self pollinated. Having the dessendant F1's in 1.16, self pollination and selection based on economic traits was done subsequently for five successive generations. The complete phenotype and genotype homozygosity was then reached having 1 selected strains ansested from 1 F1's. In the summer season of 1 1.4, a large scale field experiment was designed and applicated to evaluate these promising nine selected strains side by side with their original 1 cultivars.

The most improtant results obtained can be summarized as follows:

- Differences between all the studied traits were shown to be highly significant for the ^q selected strains as well as ^g original cultivars.
- The <code>q</code> selected strains surpassed their <code>\xi\$</code> original cultivars with respect to the average total yield of pod/plant. It was recorded as <code>\tinf,vq</code> gr for the <code>q</code> selected strains <code>, qiv,\xi of the q original \xi cultivars .</code>
- Line number o gave the highest mean of yield quantity (۱۸۳۹, of gr.) in comparison to the highest cultivar Balady (۱۰۷۳, Agr.).
- Lines number and having and having surpassed all a cultivars with respect to yield quantity. Also lines "it and hacted in the same manner as the rest of lines."
- Line number [£] showed the least values for the most studied characters. Line number ^o gave the highest values with respect to days to first flower, number of fruits, number of branches and number of leaves.
- All the nine selected lines showed earlier in comparison to $\frac{1}{2}$ cultivars except Romy cultivar. -Lines number $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ gave the highest number of friuts.
- Lines number " o and " were the shortest as plant height while line number " was the longest ('^٩, " cm) at all.
- Line number \ showed the highest value with respect to friut weight (\(\forall \), \(\text{gr} \) while line number \(\xi \) was the lowest (\(\xi \) gr) with respect to this character.
- There was a negative significant correlation between plant hight and both number of node and days to first flower. The same was found between fruit length and fruit diameter. Also, there was a highly positive significant correlation between number of fruit and all of number of branches, number of leaves and fruit weight. A highly positive significant correlation between total number of fruits/plant and both fruit weight and number of fruits per plant were detected. Also, a heighly positive significant correlation was noticed between fruit diameter and fruit weight and between number of node and days to first flower. Thus, it could be conclouded that most of these selected lines are useful for commercial cultivation.

INTRODUCTION

The dramatic expantion of the Egyptian population as well as the drop of national economy caused by the glorious january Toth revolution made it obligatory to increase food production as an ultimate goal. Vegetables consist

a major part of food consumed by the Egyptian population. One of the important vegetable crops in Egypt is okra (*Abelmoschus* esculentus).

In Okra, it is possible to raise green fruit and seed yield as well as the quality by improving agricultural practices and applying suitable breeding programs. Many attempts were done trying to improve several okra characters among them Wahba ۲۰۰2; Masoud et al... ۲۰۰۷; Abo El-khair ۲۰۰۳; Ragheb et al.., ۱۹۹٤; El-Shaikh and Mohammed, ۲۰۰۹; Mistry and Vashi, ۲۰۱۱ and Guddadamath et al.. ۲۰۱۱. All of the previous researchers found and noticed huge variations for okra traits especially the Egyptian local cultivars (Abd El-maksoud et al., ۱۹۸٤; Damarany and Farag, ۱۹۹٤; Hussein, ۱۹۹٤ and Rashwan, ۲۰۱۱).

In the Egyptian delta, great variations in vegetative, earliness, yield componants and pod quality in okra plants were recorded. In addition, selecting for yield characters with significant positive relationships both genotypically and phenotypically will subsequantly increase yield. Therefore, the present investigation was designed as an attempt to use an important inbreeding and selection programs to select superior strains dominates the local cultivars.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

The present study was carried out during the summer seasons through The up to The at Baramon experimental farm of Horticulture Institute (Mansoura Research Station, ARC). Early in Y · · ٤ season there were FY plant populations produced from selfing F1 resulting from hybridization between sort of four local cultivars i.e. Romv(R).Baladv(B).Mansoura Red(HM), and Cairo Red(HK). Twelf FY populations (all possible hybrids of Okra) were planted and well noticed. Selection of individual plants based on earliness, high number of pods, pod shape and color and uniformition of plant phenotype with moderate vegetable growth was carried out. Inbreeding of the selected plants was carried out for several successive generations and the pollination technique method discribed by Lee (1941) was followed. After o generations of inbreeding and selection, nine strains were selected after their complete homoginisity. The nine selected strains and the local & cultivars were evaluated during the summer season of Your at ElBaramon Farm of Mansoura Research Station, Horticultural Institute, ARC, Egypt. Seeds of all \" genotypes (\(\xi\) cultivars + \(\gamma\) selected strains) were sown in April 5th. The experimental design was a complete randomized block with three replicates. Each plot area was 'Y m' including & rows, each of & m length and νο cm width and one plant per hill ۲۰ cm apart. Growing plants were thinned to leave one plant per hill just before first irregation. The agricultural practices were regularly done according to the general program of okra cultivation as reported by the Egyptian Ministry of Agriculture. The pedigree of obtaining the nine selected strains was represented in Table (1).

Statistical Analysis:

Data obtained throught this investigation were statistically analyzed according to the methods mentioned in (Cochran and Cox, 1904).

RESULTS AND DISSCUSSION

This investigation was carried out at the aim of selecting promising lines of okra. Data in Table ($^{\gamma}$) represents the analysis of variance and mean squares for ten traits studied in ($^{\gamma}$) tested genotypes of okra.

As shown from Table (۲), it's obvious that variations were highly significant for all studied characters as well as between all the ۱۳ genotypes under study i.e (Between & parents and a selected lines). Also, highly significant differences were noticed within each group of genotypes.

These significant differences allows further comparisons within and between the tested genotypes. Hence, defining the best order of them from the view point of economical importnance.

Data in Table ($^{\circ}$) represents the mean performance and standard deviation of studied traits in $^{\sharp}$ parents and $^{\mathfrak{q}}$ selected promising lines of okra. In general, the $^{\mathfrak{q}}$ selected lines surpassed the $^{\sharp}$ original cultivars used in this study for most characters . It was ($^{\circ}^{\vee}$ - $^{\vee}^{\wedge}$, $^{\vee}$) and ($^{\circ}^{\vee}$ - $^{\circ}^{\mathfrak{q}}$) days to first flower for original cultivars and $^{\mathfrak{q}}$ selected lines, respectively. The shortest period to first flower was recorded as $^{\circ}^{\vee}$ days for the selected lines $^{\vee}$:

To show how is the bedigree program used is useful in selecting promising lines, the following example of the obtained data is given as following:

The original cultivar Romy (R) was crossed as giving female gamets along with the original cultivar Mansoura Red (HM) as male which resulted in F¹ and subsequently in F¹-¹. The successive selections applied to F¹-¹ for five generations resulted in lines $\frac{\epsilon}{2}$ and $\frac{\delta}{2}$.

Also for the number of fruits / plant , it was found as follows :

i.e the line \circ gave the highest number of fruits per plant, while line \circ gave the least number of fruits / plant (\circ :..).

With respect to plant height, the shortest value was ($^{1}\xi$ cm) recorded for Balady and the tallest was ($^{7}\Lambda^{9}$, cm) for line 7 .

While line \circ gave a higher number ($1\cdot, 1$) of branches /plant surpassing all the selected lines, the original cultivar Balady was with ($1\cdot$) branches /plant.

Data in Table $^{\tau}$ also represents that the selected lines surpassed the $^{\xi}$ original cultivars with respect to total product of pods weight per plant all over the season. The general mean of the nine selected lines could be calculated as $^{1717, \sqrt{9}}$ gr, while it could be calculated as $^{917, \xi 1}$ gr for the $^{\xi}$ original cultivars. In the mean time, line $^{\circ}$ showed the greatest total product of pods weight as $^{137, \xi \xi}$ gr).

So, arranging the 9 selecting lines in this respect descendingly will be :

It was noticed that line ½ gave the least values for most of the studied characters.

These findings are in accordance with what was found by some investigators who noticed high variation for pods yield of the Egyptian local cultivars of okra (Abd El-Hafez and Salah, \(\frac{1}{2}\text{V} \); Damarany and Farag , \(\frac{1}{2}\text{E}; Hussien \, \(\frac{1}{2}\text{E}; Ragheb \) et al.. , \(\frac{1}{2}\text{E}; Abo El-Khair \, \frac{1}{2}\text{V} \) and Rashwan \(\frac{1}{2}\text{V} \)). The quality of okra is determined by pod length, diameter, weight and color. It's clear from Table \(\frac{1}{2}\text{ that pod length ranged from } \frac{1}{2}\text{V} \) cm up to \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \) cm in original cultivars and \(\frac{1}{2}\text{P} \rightarrow \rightarrow \frac{1}{2}\text{T} \) in selected lines. The shortest \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \) was represented by Balady cultivar, while the tallest \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \), was recorded for Romy cultivar . The average of pod diameter ranged from \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \) cm in Romy cultivar to \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \) in Balady. The pod color was green for lines \(\frac{1}{2}\text{T} \text{P} \) and \(\frac{1}{2}\text{N} \) and \(\frac{1}{2}\text{P} \) in Sale \(\frac{1}{2}\text{P} \) and \(\frac{1}{2}\text{P

It was obvious that differences noticed among the selected strains and their original cultivars of okra were highly significant. This finding proves that these strains are genetically different and constitutes a wide range of variation for further study in breeding programs.

Finally, Table ° represents data on the correlation between the ten measured traits. There was a negative significant correlation between plant hight and both number of node and days to first flower. The same was found between fruit length and fruit diameter.

Also, there was a highly positive significant correlation between number of friut and all of number of branches, number of leaves and fruit weight.

A highly positive significant correlation between total number of fruits/plant and both fruit weight and number of fruits per plant were detected. Also, a heighly positive significant correlation was noticed between fruit diameter and fruit weight and between number of node and days to first flower.

These correlations threw the lights on the relationship between the studied genetic characters each others .

إنتخاب بعض السلالات المبشرة من خلال طريقة سجلات النسب في الباميا سهير السيد عبده الجندي

قسم بحوث الخضر – معهد بحوث البساتين – مركز البحوث الزراعية – مصر

أجريت هذه الدراسة بغرض الحصول على سلالات من الباميا مستنبطة بطريقة سجلات النسب وذلك بتطبيق برنامج تربية بمحطة بحوث البرامون بالمنصورة ، حيث تم الحصول على جميع نباتات الجيل الأني الناتجة إنعزاليا من الجيل الأول لأربعة آباء أصلية (رومي ، بلدى ، أحمر منصورة ، أحمر قاهرة). وقد تم التلقيح الذاتي والإنتخاب لنباتات الجيل الثاني في صيف عام ٢٠٠٤ لكل سلالة على حده وذلك لمدة خمسة أجيال متتالية حتى تم التوصل إلى التماثل الوراثي تماما. وقد تم الحصول على تسعة من أفضل هذه السلالات حيث قيمت جنبا إلى جنب مع الأربعة أصناف الأصلية في تجربة حقلية خلال الموسم الصيفي 8٠٠٠

وكانت أهم النتائج المتحصل عليها ما يلى:-

- كانت الإختلافات عالية المعنوية لجميع الصفات تحت الدراسة وذلك للأباء و للسلالات التسعة .
- تفوقت السلالات التسعة بشكل عام من حيث كمية المحصول للنبات الواحد خلال الموسم على كل من الأباء الأصلية حيث كان المتوسط العام هو ١٢١٣,٧٩ جرام و ١١٧,٤١ جرام على الترتيب.
- أعطت السلالة رقم $^{\circ}$ أعلى متوسط كمية محصول (١٨٣٩,٥٤) مقارنة بأعلى قيمة لأعلى صنف وهو البلدى (١٠٧٣,٨). ومن حيث كمية المحصول أيضا تفوقت السلالات $^{\circ}$ و $^{\circ}$ و و و و و ملى جميع الأصناف الأربعة. كما تفوقت أيضا السلالات $^{\circ}$ و و $^{\circ}$ على جميع الأصناف الأربعة. كما تفوقت أيضا السلالات $^{\circ}$ وقد أعلى القيم من حيث أعطت السلالة $^{\circ}$ أقل القبم لمعظم الصفات تحت الدراسة ، كما أعطت السلالة $^{\circ}$ أعلى القيم من حيث التبكير و عدد الثمار و عدد الأفرع. وتعتبر السلالات التسع جميعها مبكرة إذا ما قورنت بالأصناف الأربعة ما عدا الصنف الرومي.
- أبدت السلالات ٥ و ٦ و ١ و٧ أنها هي الأعلى في عدد الثمار. ومن ناحية أخرى فإن السلالات ٣ و٥ و٢ هي الأقصر من حيث صفة طول النبات بينما السلالة ٦ هي الأطول على الإطلاق (٢٨٩,٣ سم). وقد سجلت السلالة ١ القيمة الأعلى من حيث صفة وزن الثمرة (٧,١ gram) بينما كانت السلالة ٤ هي الأقل (gram ٤) لذات الصفة.
- أوضحت دراسة الإرتباط بين الصفات تحت الدراسة بأن هناك إرتباطا معنويا سالبا بين طول النبات وكل من صفتى رقم العقدة وعدد الأيام للتزهير كما هو الحال بين قطر الثمرة وطول الثمرة. في حين أن الإرتباط كان معنويا جدا وموجبا بين كل من (صفتى عدد الثمار للنبات الواحد وصفة وزن الثمرة) وبين صفة محصول الثمار الكلى للنبات.وكذلك الحال بين صفة قطر الثمرة ووزن الثمرة وأيضا رقم العقدة وعدد الأيام للتزهير.

و أخيرًا يمكن أن يستنتج من هذه الدراسة أن معظم السلالات المنتخبة تكون مفيدة جدا في الزراعة على نطاق تجاري.
